DRAWING - STEP BY STEP

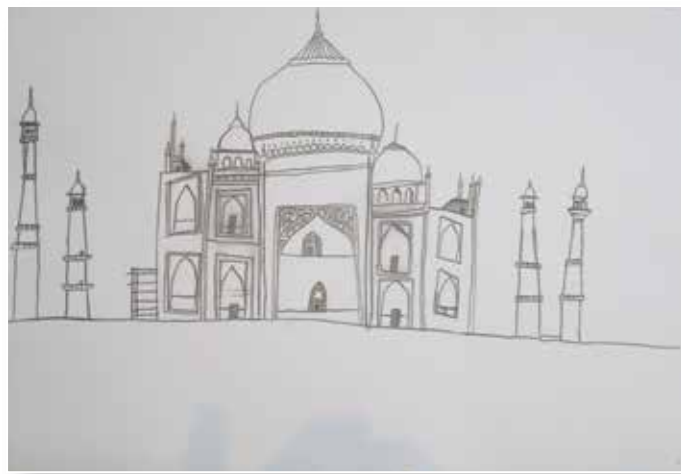
Your image

2. Experiment with different mediums, such as pencil, fine liner, water colour, pen and ink.
